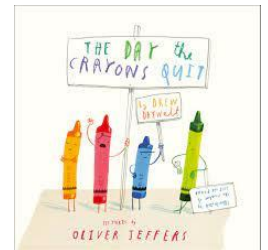

This week's focus: Year 2 Common Exception Words

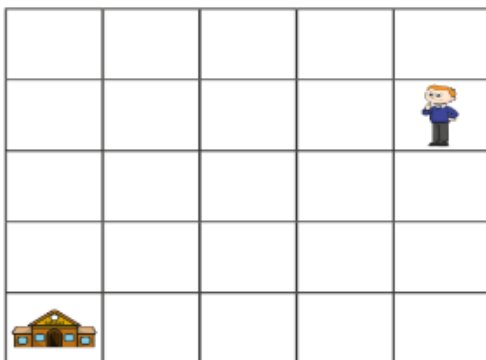
