In Literacy this week, we have been revising all of the sounds and tricky words that we have learnt. We have been building on our previous learning of reading words ending in 'ing' and 'ed' such as 'painting' and 'crowded' etc. We practised reading the longer words using the chunking method and when we became secure with this, we have been reading these words in one go.

In Numeracy, we have been focusing on forming our numbers correctly, remembering the number formation rhymes to help us when needed. The children enjoyed writing their numbers as far as they could go.

As part of our Enquiry Learning this week, we have been learning all about different sports, sharing our favourite sports and finding out why exercise is healthy for us. We have been busy practising for our upcoming sports day and have been designing our own sports kits.

Next week will be continuing our Enquiry Learning all about Healthy Bodies and Super Sports. We will spend the week thinking about feeling and being healthy.

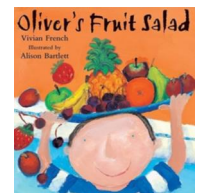

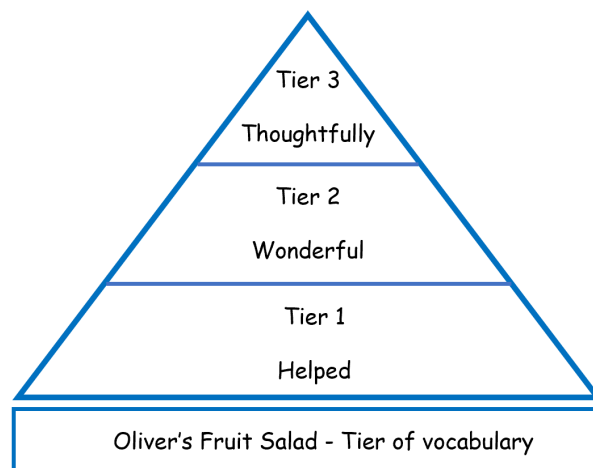
