

In English this week, we have continued our work based on the story 'Traction Man' and we have written our own version of a new story set at a beach. We have planned our problem in the story and how this will be solved using drawings and key vocabulary. In Maths, we have learnt what a fraction is: **a part of a whole**. We have looked at fractions of shapes and patterns. The children now know that the top number in a fraction is called the **numerator** which tells us how many parts we have, and the bottom number is the **denominator** which tells us how many parts the whole is divided into.
